<b>1 Point Penalties</b> a. Losing working advantage b. Noise directed to Cattle c. Toe, foot or stirrup on the shoulder of horse d. Working out of position	<b>3 Point Penalties</b> a. Hot quit b. Cattle picked up or scattered c. Spur in shoulder d. Pawing or biting cattle e. Failure to make deep cut f. Back fence	<b>5 Point Penalties</b> a. Horse quitting cow b. Losing a cow c. Changing cow after specific Commitment
<b>-0- Score – DQ</b> a. Illegal Equipment, turn tail, braided tail b. Excessive disturbance of the herd to the point that the exhibitor is asked to leave arena c. Two hands on reins while working cow, except when exhibiting in a snaffle/ or showing youth or green. Picking up and adjusting tangled reins away from a cut will not be penalty or DQ.
