**Show Day Support** – Moving scribe positions to paid positions



#### **Two-Day Show Proposal**

The idea of changing to a Two-Day show was brought up during the 2018 show season. The show day begins at 9am and has previously gone well into the night.

- Clean up and Tear Down would be pushed to late Sunday
- Those hauling in from out of state would be late leaving on Sunday
- Our stalls are full, this may be an opportunity for people to haul in and show one day and leave to free up stalls for Sunday Exhibitors
- Trail and Ranchmanship patterns would be run individually one exhibitor at a time, the courses would need to be torn down and reset between classes or the patterns would need to be shrunk to allow for both classes to be ran in the arena simultaneously
- The infield updates have significantly improved the length of the infield classes. The August show infield finished around 2pm and the arena finished around 8:30

## **Treasurers Report**

We did have to cancel 3 classes at the July show. Refunds were offered at the office during the August Show. We still netted a profit of \$1800 for the day. We did authorize a few large purchases for the timers and display boards.

#### **Ribbons**

It was decided at the June meeting that we would not purchase ribbons for the show. We would extend the year end awards to 5 places. We have received feedback and have seen many upset kids. We would like to revisit the idea of ordering ribbons. Lisa would like to ask for a new volunteer to handle ordering and inventorying the ribbons. Angie Erwin & Diana McGee have volunteered to take over the Ribbon Ordering.

There was a motion made to resume ordering and handing out ribbons. The motion was tabled until the September Meeting.

### **T-Shirts**

Grey T-shirts have been ordered and will be for sale at the September Show \$15. If you have already ordered a shirt from Lisa – please plan to pick up your shirt.

## **Freestyle Reining**

We have 7 people signed up. Jennifer Hohmann & Heather Baker have donated and organized items for a "Swag Bag" for each participant. We need to cutoff entries on 8/10/19 to allow time to purchase gifts for the Swag Bags. We may take entries up to the show time but those late entrants will not get a bag.

We need to discuss the Prize for the winner. In 2018 we gave away tickets to the Freestyle Reining at Congress.
