#### **Purchase new Software**

The software should allow for 1 show sheet per contestant. It should eliminate the short sheet for each class entry on show day. The software should reduce the number of show day office staff. It will also support the desired random draw process.

## Judges

Judge Committee is working on securing judges for all show weekends. We need a better solution for judge location during the shows. Currently use the bed of a truck and the announcers stand for judge location

#### Suggestions

- 1. Lifeguard type of chairs with gate panels positioned around the chair in the arena for cutting classes and outside the fence all remaining classes
- 2. Scaffolding positioned in the arena with gate panels for cutting classes and outside the arena for all remaining classes

Judge location for infield classes needs to be centralized and will be reviewed in the trail committee

## **Class Order Display**

How can line up be more visible to riders in the arena. Current set up requires riders to exit the arena to view the class line up

- i. Larger White board
- ii. Clip board hanging on the fence

#### Infield Changes

Give the judge a preset 30-minute break. Time will be determined and posted on the show bill

#### **Judge Requirements**

Judge Committee will validate required support for judges the day of the show. Includes requirements for provided scribe. The club will have 2 trained scribes on standbye if the judge does not bring their own. If the club provides a scribe the position will be paid for the day.

#### ≠Working Ranch Horse

Do we want/need remove this class or change the requirements. There is a difference in the time allotments for Working Ranch and Working Cow horse. Do we need to make a change to the classes or leave as is?

- Leave class as is

Leave the class on the show bill; if no one enters no impact to the show

#### **≠Versatility**

We had no entries in this class for 2019. Do we need to make changes to the requirements to entice future entries or should we just remove the designation from the show season? There was feedback that it is difficult to manage the required cow and infield classes in the given time. What options are available to make

- Leave class as is
  - Motion JK, 2<sup>nd</sup> AB, VOTE: Unanimous

#### **±Green Rider**

Do we need to add a Green Rider designation? Same classes as Rookie Rider but change classes to W/T/C
