SECRETARY REPORT – APRIL 25, 2026

When: Saturday, April 25, 2026 @ 11:00 AM

The meeting was held at the showgrounds following the work day. The President, Donnie brought the meeting to order at 11:00 am. It had 22 participants present.

Old Business:

The work party date originally planned for Sat., April 18th was rescheduled due to conflicting schedules with some attendees. It was one of the fastest set ups and everything went very well thanks to all that attended to help.

The meeting following was for any last minute details being worked out so that the first show gets off the ground with great success and will begin our show season.

~ Discussion began with Melissa stating T shirts will be set up in the office for purchase. The price will be \$25 per shirt. If a 2026 shirt is purchased the buyer may choose an old club shirt of their choice for free to try and clear the old inventory out.

~ Office Help may not be needed to assist Zane day of the show. Joan will make sure the office forms and equipment will be ready for him and help get him set up. Kris suggested we all pop in through out the show day just to check in and make sure he doesn't need anything.

~ Donnie informed everyone that the announcer was all set and is Ryan Rhoads. A few might need to assist him with running the timer during the cattle classes until he gets used to it.

~ The question of hay needing to be supplied again this year for the cattle was brought up and yes it will be needed and 5 to 6 bales should cover it per show. Mike Wilson said he would bring Mays show hay.

~The cattle surcharge fee was discussed again as to what to do after May show. It had been already decided the May show would be \$50 one time fee per anyone showing in the cattle classes. A suggestion was made for the rest of the shows just raising the class fee's across the board since they have not been increased for quite some time. This would help spread the expense around and help cover the extra expense. So it was decided all dry classes will increase \$5 and the cattle classes will increase \$10, leaving modified class alone as it stands. 1st motion was made by Fred, with Joan seconding that motion. Everyone passed..

~ Addition to raising prices a vote was made also to increase Friday night cattle practises from \$40 to \$50. Again Jaan made first motion and Ted 2nd the motion. Motion passed..

~ It was brought up to please get your memberships in as soon as you can please. And that class pre- show entry is up and ready through Zane and to please get registered. Also pay the cattle surcharge as well prior to the show. Anyone not pre-entered can do so still at the show.

New Business:

~ {Revisiting ideas from a previous meeting} on trying to grow the youth memberships Fred brought up an idea to maybe ask a few trainers to attend the show with a special invite to bring their students to show in the youth classes. This may build the youth memberships if they come and enjoy it. Discussion brought ideas of maybe just offering a pattern and rail classes for this. No cattle. Possibly a buckle awarded to the winner. It was suggested we wait until the last show and will be discussed further between directors later.

CLOSING: The meeting came to a close with the excitement of next weekend being the first show and how everyone is looking forward to another fun filled and rewarding year..
